Old Business:

1) Update and vote on purchase of "dog poop" boxes- discussion: Darryl Stubbs has purchased one box on his own and has installed it at the entrance to the beach at Fentress Avenue. People seem to have taken it on their own initiative to refill it with plastic bags. Cost: \$25 per box to be purchased from the SPCA. A motion for the CBCL to purchase 12 "dog poop" boxes was made by Stewart Smokler, it was seconded and passed by the attending members.

2) Update and vote on CBCL's position on Indigo Dunes project: discussion: Mark Walker presented a display of the planned development by Sandler Bros. with several copies of the planned project passed around the room. Mentioned that one factor the Sandlers are offering to the city is a donation to improve Shore Drive safety. Heidi Janicki mentioned that the meeting of the Chesapeake Bay Preservation Board has been postponed till mid/late October, and that the Sandlers would need to have all of the appropriate permits in place to seek approval from that board. Mention was made of the petition approved by Ocean Park Civic League and supported by adjacent civic leagues along Shore Drive; available at <http://sdcc.info/noindigodunes>. Main issues addressed on the petition are: a) density of project and impact on environment, b) too many units are being proposed and will impact safety on Shore Drive, and c) the strain on city services by such a large development.
